 - viii. Next committee meeting will see how you will appoint someone to take minutes. If you need a template Taryn can help create it.
 - ix. Carlyle and Taryn will look at the minutes and pull things out for the Social Media and Newsletter.

- 4. Indigenous liaison committee idea Taryn
 - a. Have talked to various groups and people about having this.
 - b. Talked to a Mountaineering club on the Island and they have a Indigenous Committee and they do various projects and are involved with Indigenous groups.
 - c. What could we offer the Indigenous groups to be involved with us at Garibaldi Park, as it's better to offer something then to take it.
 - d. Who might want to join Taryn on this Committee.
 - i. Sierra and Megan will join.
 - e. One idea would be to hire an Indigenous person to take us on guided walks in the Park.
 - f. Suggestion was to offer a donation to help hire someone.
 - g. Alex will create an Indigenous Liaison Slack Channel and invite those who want to be a part of it.
- 5. Treasurer update and proposed new funding models Megan
 - a. We have enough funds to pay back members who incurred expenses on behalf of FOGPS
 - b. We are paying our board dues and then aim to fundraise over the summer.
 - c. Question was raised about how to go about fundraising. We should have a one page overview about what we do so we can give it to them. Also a statement about where the money is going.
 - d. Megan will work on that document, Greg will ask Trail Maintenance about what it is they would like to buy to put it in the document.
 - e. We could also put this information in a Newsletter when we do it and we could also put a fundraising goal amount.

 - b. Possibly put the months/dates of when we are doing trail maintenance and start promoting.

 - b. Discussing with BC Parks South to see if we can be involved in some of their projects they have for this year, there seems to be a good amount of things they would like to see happen.
 - c. BC Parks suggested Crooked Falls Trail, Sea to Summit Trail for early season trail watch training hikes
 - d. Composting toilet at Panorama ridge trail junction, is a project we could consider to fundraise for.
 - e. Also we could build the boardwalk in Taylor Meadows if BC Parks can find a construction supervisor.
 - f. Meeting with Andrea next week to chat about some of these things.
 - g. Meet + Greet Proposed by BC Parks later in the spring we will keep you informed if you are interested.
 - h. Proposed schedule for 2023 Call for Captains and all the trail watch events. We have started the schedule in April and go through September.

- i. Please think when you are available and if you want to be a leader and if we can schedule ahead of time then we can give the information to Carlyle to post and recruit more volunteers.
- j. Trail Maintenance will send out the potential hikes in Slack.
